



Farmer's Market Recipes

Fresh recipes inspired by ingredients found at the Covington Farmer's Market, by Chefs David and Torre Solazzo of Ristorante del Porto

Pickled Pumpkin

1 medium pumpkin, cubed

6 cups white wine vinegar

2 cups sugar

3 cups water

Ingredients:

3 tbs salt

1 cinnamon stick

4 juniper berries

1 tbs peppercorns 3 tbs mustard seeds

1 tbs allspice

8 cloves garlic, sliced

6 large bay leaves

1 shallot, sliced

Cooking Instructions:

Combine all ingredients, except for the pumpkin in a stainless steel pot. Bring to a boil, continue to boil for 10 minutes. Add the pumpkin. Let boil until semisoft (about 12 minutes). Remove pumpkin and cool on sheet pan. Cool pickling liquid. Add pumpkin to cool liquid. Store in a glass jar in the refrigerator.

Lemon Grass Tea by Nick Usner of Grow Farms

Ingredients

1 tsp lemongrass



Cooking Instructions:

Pour the water over the lemongrass and steep for 5 minutes. Sweeten as desired, makes one cup of tea.
