Corned Beef And Cabbage Crock Pot Recipe

- 1 brined corned beef brisket, about 3 pounds
- 1 large yellow onion, cut into large wedges
- 3 carrots, cut into three-inch pieces (Grow.farm)
- 1/2 pound small potatoes, halved
- 2 celery stalks, cut into three-inch pieces
- 1/2 head of large green cabbage, cut into 2 inch wedges (Bartlett)
- 5 6 garlic cloves
- 6 sprigs of fresh thyme, picked
- 2 bay leaves, crushed
- 1/2 tsp mustard seeds
- 1/2 tsp fresh ground corriander
- 1/2 tsp fresh ground allspice berries
- 1/2 tsp fresh ground black pepper
- 1/2 tsp caraway
- 1 tsp kosher salt
- 12 ounces of your favorite (Irish) beer

Place onions and garlic in a 5 - 6 quart crock pot. Place the corned beef on top, and fill in the sides with the carrots, potatoes and celery. Mix all spices and herbs together in a small bowl and sprinkle over the beef. Add the beer and enough water to just cover the meat. Cook on 'high' setting for 4 1/2 to 5 hours, or until brisket is tender. Add the cabbage wedges, broken up, on top of the corned beef and cook for another half hour or so, until the cabbage is tender. Serve the beef thinly sliced with vegetables and liquid from the pot.

City Council To Address Banning Skateboar A Quick Skateboard Reminisce By Timothy Gates

I remember a time when I rode my Vision Gator (which I bought from my friend Geoff) all over the Abita Springs town hall, and for a while there, it probably upset Mayor Gowland. I would go down to the park, but the concrete was a mess, and it would always end up pitching you into the gravel or the dirt. I could usually find some skaters on a subdivision street somewhere, or better yet, a new development. There was nowhere to skate back then, and it's possible that the Covington kids won't have anywhere to skate now, at least downtown. This Tuesday, the Covington City Council will discuss banning skateboarding in downtown Covington. Banning skateboarding would set the precedent of outlawing a legitimate form of exercise and impact at least one downtown business, possibly more. If skateboards in downtown are a serious enough issue to consider banning them, then perhaps an alternative could be offered by way of a skatepark/ recreational area, as other municipalities have done. It could be an attraction for the city that encourages growth in the current business environment while promoting healthy, active lifestyles. Examples of this can be found in Hammond (Zemurray Park) and also in Mandeville (Pelican Park). 




