Covington Police Supports Child Abuse Prevention

Department Partners With Exchange Club Of West St. Tammany Chief Tim Lentz announces that the Covington Police Department has partnered with the Exchange Club of West St. Tammany in raising support for child abuse prevention. According to statistics from the Child Abuse Prevention Center (www.thecapcenter.org), in the United States alone, a report of child abuse is made every ten seconds. Almost 5 children die each day as a result of child abuse and more than three out of every four are under the age of four.



Farmer's Market Recipes

Fresh recipes inspired by ingredients found at the Covington Farmer's Market

Radish Cakes With Homemade Tziki Sauce

Featuring Veggies From Slice Of Heaven Farm

Ingredients:

May 7

First Quarter

1/4 lb radishes (cherriette, etc.), grated

1/2 lb daikon radishes, grated

1/2 onion, chopped

2 green onions, chopped

3 garlic cloves, minced

1/4 lb spinach, chopped equal parts cilantro and parsley, chopped

sea salt, cayenne, paprika (to taste)

1/2 cup bread crumbs

tblsp oil/butter

Directions:

Mix all ingredients together until a consistency is reached that will allow you to form small to medium sized patties. Add more bread crumbs or liquid as necessary. Heat a skillet and saute the patties until browned.

Tziki Sauce Ingredients:

Fage yogurt (8-12 oz) 1 cucumber, seeded & minced

1 tsp olive oil

fresh mint leaves, minced 3 cloves garlic, minced

salt, cayenne, paprika (to taste)

Directions:

Mix all ingredients together until well blended. Cover and let sit for a while. It can be served on top of the radish patties, or used as a type of dip. Other serving suggestions include pita bread, rice pilaf, a green salad and a bottle of ouzo
