

A round of Community Meetings to gain public insights and opinions regarding culture, recreation and tourism planning in southern St. Tammany Parish will begin the evening of Wednesday, August 20th in Slidell. Two additional meetings will be held the following day in Madisonville and Lacombe. The Parish's Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism initiated this Strategic Plan in May of 2014 to identify best uses for mitigated, flood-prone properties and how they may best accentuate existing outdoor recreational and habitat preservation amenities in the parish. 

Farmer's Market Recipe

2 large eggplant 2 zucchini 2 squash 6 creole tomatoes 5-6 leaves of basil 3-4 assorted bell peppers 4 toes of garlic

oil for cooking

Bring a pot of salted water to a boil. Cut an x on the bottom of the tomatoes and drop in the boiling water until they come back to a boil. Remove with a slotted spoon, allow to cool, then remove the skin. Get a base pot going with the oil, garlic and herbs, simmer on low. Chop and add tomatoes to the toasted garlic and herbs, keep at a low heat. Dice the peppers, squash and zucchini and cook on high in a separate skillet.

Peel, dice and salt the eggplant, then let it sit in a strainer to drain excess juices. Once the vegetables are cooked in the skillet, add them to the tomato sauce that is cooking on low heat. Reheat the skillet and cook the eggplant until golden brown. Add the eggplant to the sauce, and salt and

Cook on low heat for about an hour. Keep stirring the mixture periodically while it cooks. Enjoy on bread or with pasta!


