


# Seafood Stuffed Eggplant


**Courtesy Of Faust Farms** 3 large eggplants 1 chopped bell pepper 1chopped onion chopped garlic 1 pound cleaned shrimp or crawfish tails Italian breadcrumbs 2 beaten eggs 2 tablespoons oil

Cut eggplants in half lengthwise with stems still on them.



Put in pan and cover the bottom of pan with water. Place foil or cover over pan and bake at 350 degrees for approximately 20-25 minutes or until inside of eggplants are tender. Set aside and let cool. Spoon out inside of eggplant being careful not to tear the shells. Sauté seasoning and add eggplant. Cook for 10 minutes, add seafood and cook for 10 more minutes; set aside. Then add 2 beaten eggs, breadcrumbs, parmesan cheese, and season to taste. Place shells in a well greased casserole dish and stuff them with your eggplant mixture. Top with breadcrumbs, parmesan cheese, and pats of butter. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. For the first 15 minutes bake covered and then remove the cover for the remaining 15 minutes so that tops can brown. Remove from oven, serve, and enjoy.
